The Rochford Review

THE ROCHFORD REVIEW

The final recommendations of the Rochford Review panel were published just before the half term break.

The SEN Data Development Group which our Alliance leads across the County met on 3rd November to discuss ways forward in terms of supporting schools with implementing the recommendations. High on our agenda was how to support special schools and units with Recommendation 4 - the assessment of pupils in the former P1-P3 bracket for whom the recommendation is that reporting is no longer statutory.

Parallel to this, the Leading SENCos - at their meeting on 8th December - will be discussing how to train and support SENCos across the County in the use of the new "entry" and "emerging" standards which replace P4 - P8 and the higher pre-key stage standards for pupils unable to access end of Key Stage tests.

A longer summary of the Rochford Review will appear in the December edition of Inclusion News. Meanwhile, we have already organised some authoritative training open to all schools across the County, from the Vice Chair of the Rochford Review (see below).

THE ROCHFORD REVIEW: FINAL REPORT

Implications for statutory assessment in 2017 and beyond

Janet Thompson (Vice Chair of the Rochford Review, former HMI National Adviser for SEN for Ofsted & Headteacher of Dorothy Goodman School) explains the thinking behind the eight recommendations and implications for statutory assessment. There will be clarification around use of the I-Can statements for each of the new Pre-Key Stage Standards and the reporting obligations for pupils attaining at different levels within the new joined up assessment system. There will be lots of opportunity for delegates to ask questions and clarify their understanding of what schools need to be doing in response to the Rochford Review.

PEER SUPPORT AND CHALLENGE PROGRAMME FOR OUR ALLIANCE HEADTEACHERS

The three pilot triads for our Peer Support and Challenge Programme for Alliance Headteachers have got off to a very good start. Just to summarise how it works ... 3 heads work together and come to an initial seminar facilitated by a member of our strategic board. They "put on the table" something they think is going really well in their school "a celebration" and something they are working on and wish to develop "a challenge". They then learning walk each other's school, looking at those things – hence "Peer support and Challenge". Then, after all three visits, there is a final seminar where all the triads of headteachers come together to share their learning. We have piloted this with three triads this term (all have had their first seminar).

If you would like to be involved – it is **FREE** to headteachers/deputies in our Alliance. It would be helpful if you came to us with a ready-agreed triad – but not compulsory. We can match-make.

PEER SUPPORT AND CHALLENGE PROGRAMME FOR SENCOS ACROSS THE COUNTY

Works in a similar way as the Headteachers' programme on the previous page, except with SENCos. The initial and final seminars are facilitated by a Leading SENCo. This is open to all SENCos in the county, not just those in our alliance and there is a £250 charge for the whole programme. Three triads have already started, with many more to follow.

Or ... you can do it after the event (we will always send you a reminder email and a link).




