- adhere to the guidance set out by the government so protective measures are in place to minimise the risk of COVID as much as possible



## **Parents/Carers will**

- make sure my child is ready for school when transport arrives
- make sure my child attends school regularly and inform school of his/her absence on the first day of his/her absence
- keep the school informed of any concerns that might affect my child's learning or behaviour, including any major events at home that may affect my child's emotions
- support the school's policies and encourage my child to value learning
- try to attend Annual Reviews and discuss my child's progress and maintain regular contact with the school through the 'Home/ School Book'
- share with the school the involvement of any professional help to ensure we work together for the child's benefit.
- get to know my child's life at Fairfields
- monitor if my child or anyone in our household has symptoms of COVID-19 (i.e. a high temperature; a new, continuous cough; or a loss or change to their sense of smell/taste). If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and we will follow the government guidance.
- treat all staff with respect. I will behave in an appropriate manner, at all times, when on school premises.



- phone the school if I need to speak to a member of staff urgently.
- support the school's procedures in ensuring a safe environment
- do my best to support my child to complete any learning set for them when at home, and get in touch with the school if this won't be possible for any reason
- provide my child with a healthy snack and packed lunch (if they do not have school dinners)
- support school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home.
- keep school informed of who to contact in case of emergency.
- not publish any photographs I take at school events onto social networking sites or other public areas on the internet
