Parents will:

- get to know my child's life at Fairfields
- come and collect my child from school as soon as possible if they are poorly. If I am unable to come and collect them I will identify another person who will.
- phone the school if I need to speak to a member of staff urgently.
- support the school's procedures in ensuring a safe environment
- do my best to support my child to complete any learning set for them when at home, and get in touch with the school if this won't be possible for any reason
- treat staff with respect
- provide my child with a healthy snack and packed lunch (if they do not have school dinners)
- support school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home.
- keep school informed of who to contact in case of emergency.
