

Pupil outcomes 2016-2017

We are delighted to report that pupils at end of Key Stage 1 & 2 made outstanding progress because:

- From year to year pupils have sustained outstanding progress.
- The vast majority of KS1 and KS2 pupils have met or exceeded expectations in reading and all have met or exceeded expectations in writing and maths
- Pupils have developed excellent skills, understanding and knowledge, considering their different starting points.
- When looking at the wider curriculum, progress across year groups was substantial with the majority of pupils either exceeding or meeting expected progress.
- There was little to no variation between different vulnerable groups of pupils, including disadvantaged pupils, against their peers.



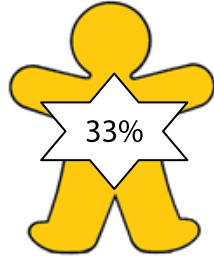

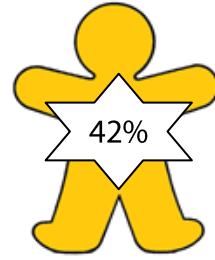

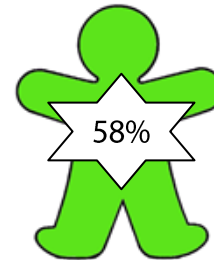

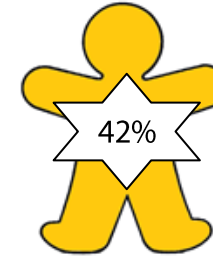

KS1 Progress from YR – Y2

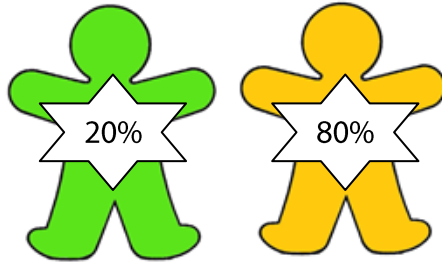

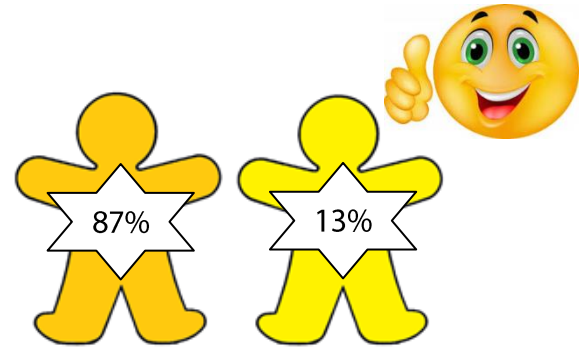

KS2 Progress from Y2 – Y6

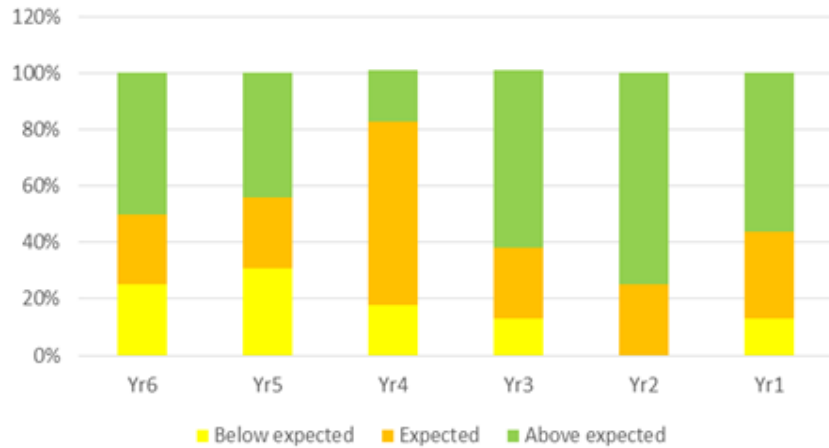

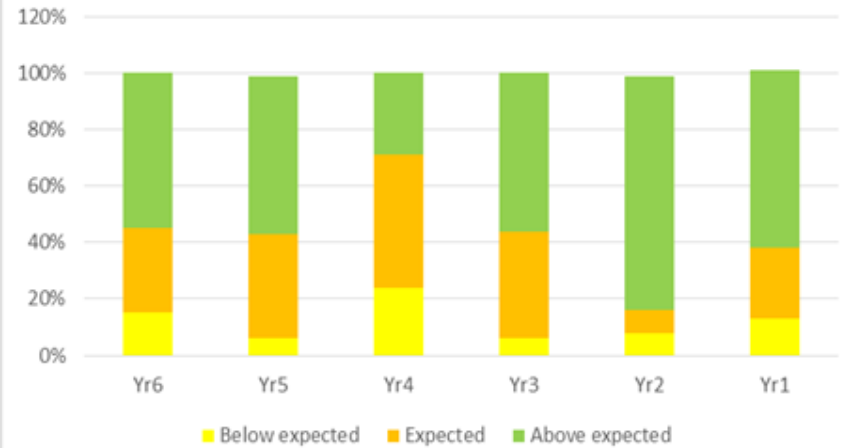

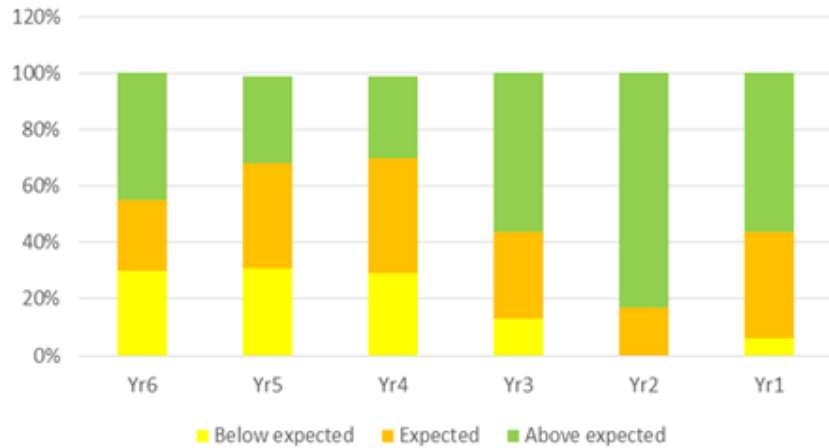
Year Group Progress - Reading



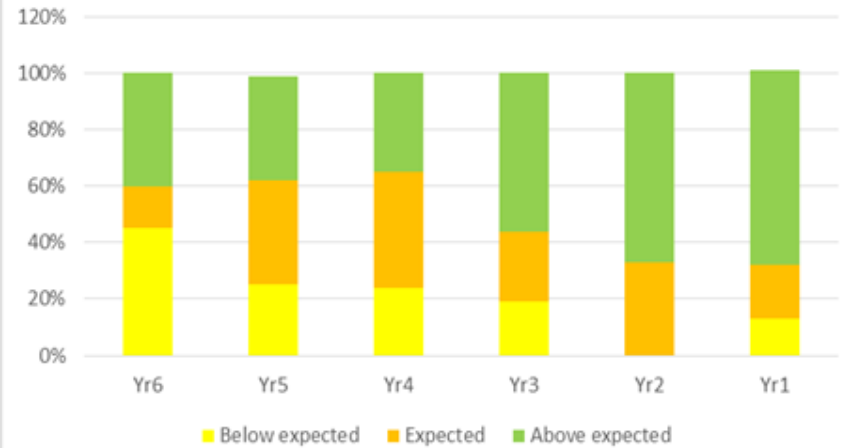
Year Group Progress - Writing
